
AMERICAN INSTITUTE OF PHYSICS TIB DIGITAL BACK FILE ARCHIVE LICENSE AGREEMENT

- Terms and Conditions for Back File Authorized Users -

1. Authorized Users. An Authorized User is any user defined below:

a. Back File Authorized User. A Back File Archive Authorized User is any individual who either (i) is an employee, staff, and/or student visitor officially affiliated with an academic or research institution admitted under the licence; or (ii) is a contractor, Publisher, and/or consultant officially affiliated with that institution, but such an individual is authorized only for purposes related to the legitimate business needs of the institution.

b. Access to Back Files for Members of the General Public. To the extent that the library of an institution admitted under the licence provides public access to electronic publications, the institution may allow access to and copying from the electronic form of the Back File Archive of the Journals by members of the public subject to the terms of this Agreement. Such public access will be only from designated terminals with an IP address controlled by and physically located in the library of the institution.

2. Permitted & Prohibited Uses.

a. Permitted Uses: Authorized Users may:

- (i) browse, search, retrieve, and view an AIP Archival Journal;
- (ii) make one print copy of the output of any search; such copies may not be sold to anyone;
- (iii) download search results of individual articles, or discrete items or portions of such articles, to a data storage device or communicate those results electronically, provided that such data is used solely for their personal, scholarly, educational or scientific research or internal business use or the use of any other Authorized User and are not made available to anyone who is not an Authorized User; and
- (iv) also transmit such material to a third party colleague in print copy, for personal use or scholarly, educational, or scientific research or private study but in no case collect any money for any such transmission or allow any re-sale.

Authorized Users may only use this online access in a way that conforms to this agreement or any additional restrictions from any applicable laws and regulations.

Interlibrary loan policy: Authorized Users may download and print individual articles that are then hand-delivered, mailed, faxed, or securely transmitted by using Ariel or its equivalent, to a requester under the Authorized User's interlibrary loan procedures, so long as the requesting institution is a noncommercial library located in Germany . No other form of interlibrary loan via electronic transmission or forwarding of material is permitted.

Publisher grants Authorized Users permission to use data or brief quotations from the AIP Archival Journals. Authorized Users shall retain all copyright and other legal notices on all copies of material from an AIP Archival Journal.

b. Prohibited Uses.

i. Prohibited Alterations. Authorized Users shall not alter, recompile, distribute, or republish (beyond the brief quotations permitted in 2(a), above) any journal text, or any portion thereof, including without limitation any copyright, proprietary, and/or other legal notices contained therein, in any form or medium.

ii. Abusive Usages. In the event of any abusive usage of the AIP Archival Journals, access of the institution where offending use occurs may be discontinued. Abusive usage shall include but not be limited to practices such as consecutive downloads of entire issues or downloads of articles or abstracts at a rate that exceeds what could reasonably be expected as the maximum rate of use by an individual scholar.
