

**By-laws on the assignment of the specialisation areas
in the Master's Degree Programme
Electrical Engineering and Information Technology
at Deggendorf Institute of Technology
of 1 October 2022**

Based on Article 13 (2), clause 2, 59 (2), clause 2 of the Bavarian Higher Education Act (BayHSchG) of 23 May 2006 (GVBl. p. 245, Bay RS 2210-1-1WK), last amended by Sect. 2 of the Act of 23 December 2021 (GVBl. p. 669), Deggendorf Institute of Technology hereby enacts the following by-laws:

Section 1 Capacities

- (1) The master's degree programme Electrical Engineering and Information Technology is divided into the two specialisations Automation Technologies (AT) and Electronic and Communication systems (ENS), in accordance with the applicable study and examinations regulations in their currently valid version.
- (2) Due to the full utilisation of the training capacities, only a limited number of maximum available places are available for the respective specialisation:
 - Specialisation in Automation Technology (AT) 28 places
 - Specialisation in Electronic and Communication Systems (ENS) 17 places
- (3) The assignment of the available places shall be carried out in accordance with the following sections 2 and 3.

Section 2 Selection criteria

- (1) The selection of applicants for the master's degree programme in Electrical Engineering and Information Technology takes place on the basis of a procedure for determining the degree programme-specific aptitude, which is regulated in section 5 of the study and examination regulations in their currently valid version.
- (2) The results of this selection procedure are used as a criterion for the assignment of places in the respective specialisation. The participants with the best results in the ranking will be considered for the assignment. Upon application, the applicants already indicate a desired specialisation area. If no selection for a specialisation is made during the application, students will be assigned a specialisation by the course coordinator of the Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Media Technology.

Section 3 Procedure

- (1) The course coordinator is responsible for allocating the available places in the respective specialisation.
- (2) Applicants receive the result of the selection procedure and the notification of which specialisation they have been allocated to no later than two weeks after the selection procedure has been carried out, together with the notification of admission from the University Centre.

Section 4 Coming into effect

The by-law shall enter into effect on 1 October 2021 and shall apply to all students commencing their studies in the 2022/23 winter semester.
