#### What is EXIST-Women?

EXIST-Women is a nationwide funding program aimed at supporting women interested in starting their own businesses at universities and research institutions in the pre-founding phase. It focuses particularly on the development of their entrepreneurial personality and the further refinement of their business idea.

# Who is eligible for funding?

Female graduates (the degree may have been obtained more than 5 years ago), female researchers, female students (with a bachelor's degree or having completed at least half of their academic requirements), and women with vocational training and a connection to the university who are interested in entrepreneurship. Participation is also possible alongside studies or professional commitments. While having a specific business idea is optional, the program supports ideas that may not be knowledge- or research-based but are oriented towards future economic activities. Women who have previously received entrepreneurship support from federal or state programs are excluded from this funding.

## How is support provided?

- A 12-month qualification program
- Individual coaching by the experienced Startup Campus team
- Entrepreneurial support from a mentor
- Nationwide network for female entrepreneurs
- Assistance in finding co-founders
- Development of a suitable business model
- Creation of a roadmap for the next steps towards self-employment
- Access to workspaces in the Startup Lab and the opportunity to use its infrastructure
- One-time financial support of €2,000 (e.g., for coaching, travel expenses, or validating your business idea)
- Optionally, a 3-month scholarship if you have no income or work a maximum of 20 hours per week
- €1,000 €3,000 per month (depending on qualifications) + childcare supplement

# What are my obligations as a participant?

- Attendance at the Entrepreneur Seminar and centrally offered EXIST-Women events
- Participation in relevant events organized by the Startup Campus (both online and in-person)
- Scheduled individual consultation sessions (with startup advisors and mentors)
- Attendance at networking events
- Compilation of the business idea summary (OnePager) at the end of the funding period (no obligation to start a business!)

#### How can I participate in the program?

- 1. Submit a written application
- 2. Initial evaluation by the Startup Campus jury
- 3. Personal presentation
- 4. Decision by the Startup Campus jury

### **Written Application:**

- Motivational letter, 1 page A4
- Brief introduction including name, field of study, and personal background
- Brief description of the business idea, if already available
- Demonstration of interest in entrepreneurship
- Explanation of motivation for participating in the program
