

**1. By-laws on Amendments in the Study and Examination
Regulations for the
Master Programme of Mechatronic and Cyber-Physical
Systems at the Deggendorf Institute of Technology
Dated 15th March 2019**

On the basis of Art. 13 Para. 2 Clause 2, 58 Para. 1, 61 Para. 2 Clause 1 of the Bavarian University and College Act (BayHSchG) of 23rd May 2006 (BayRS 2210-1-1-K), last amended by § 1 of the Act of 10th July 2018 (GVBl. p. 533), the Deggendorf Institute of Technology enacts the following by-laws:

§ 1 Amendments

The study and examination regulations for the Master programme of Mechatronic and Cyber-Physical Systems of 1st October 2018 shall change as follows:

§ 3 Para. 2 shall be reformulated:

- (2) Additionally, proof of the following language skills should be furnished for this programme:
- English: English language skills at level B2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference.
 - German: Knowledge of the German language at level A2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for foreign applicants.

Regarding the proof, the regulations set out in § 3 of the framework examination regulations for additional training in foreign languages and general academic elective courses of the Deggendorf Institute of Technology shall apply as amended.

**§ 2
Coming into effect**

The amendment shall come into effect on 15th March 2019.

It is issued based on the resolution of the Senate of the Deggendorf Institute of Technology dated 17th October 2018 and the regulatory approval of the Vice President of Deggendorf Institute of Technology dated 15th March 2019.
