The Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering, abbreviated as GATE, is an internationally accepted, standardised graduate admission exam conducted considered to be one of the most competitive exams in Indian higher education. The GATE exam is to screen candidates for admission into postgraduate engineering programmes. The GATE exam is conducted jointly by the following seven Indian Institutes of Technology on behalf of the National Coordination Board:

GRE is a multiple-choice, computer-based, standardized exam that is frequently required for admission to graduate degree programs globally. Developed and administered by the test provider ETS, the object of GRE is to compare qualifications of applicants for graduate-level academic work.
