The ability to use language confidently and appropriately in every-day, study and professional situations is a necessary key skill for all professions and is essential for both future working life and in preparation for studying or internships abroad.

Please note that in all language courses students are required to attend at least 75 % of all lectures in order to be permitted to the exam. According to this 75 % rule, for subjects worth 2 ECTS, a student can be absent only three times* during the semester and for subjects worth 4 ECTS, a student can be absent only six times*.

*One time = 2 Teaching Units = 2x45 minutes

"Career Start into German Technology Companies"


