Compulsory **exam registration is possible from 6th November 2020 to 20th November 2020**. In light of the particularities related to the Corona pandemic, any exam registrations made before or after this period of time are **not** possible.

Similarly to the previous semester, an official **de-registration** from exams up to 7 days before the respective exam is not necessary but **urgently requested**.

Unlike the previous semester, in the winter semester 2020/2021, a **medical certificate** is necessary in case you need to **withdraw from an examination** due to sudden illness. This medical certificate is to prove clearly that your ill condition could not be known before taking the exam. For this purpose, the following template needs to be used:

Any subsequent de-registration from examinations is **not** possible in this semester.

The hygienic regulations of the DIT valid at this point in time apply to **written examinations in presence** (schr.P.) The examination rooms will be announced on the examination schedule shortly before the respective exam. Please come to your exam in a timely manner and schedule slightly more time due to possible hygienic measures.

On the examination schedule, the latest possible submission date has been specified for **student research projects** (PStA). The issue date, processing time as well as the type of submission (e.g. via upload on iLearn) will be defined by the corresponding examiner.

Oral exams (mdl.P.) are generally conducted via web conference. The meeting link and the time schedule will be communicated to you by the corresponding examiner. Both your microphone and your camera need to be activated for the entire duration of the examination and you need to be alone in your room.

During the examination, you need to be able to identify yourself with your student ID.

In light of the dynamic situation in relation to COVID-19, **all parts of the examination schedule are subject to short-term changes** in order to enable exams. Before your respective exams, please inform yourself daily on any changes that might have occurred.

Please note the following regulations concerning **re-sit examinations**:

- You are not automatically registered for re-sit exams. Therefore, you need to register independently for re-sit exams!
- Any failed first attempts at exams need to be taken again in the following semester.
- Any failed second attempts at exams need to be taken again, at the latest two semesters after the second failed attempt.

Correctly abiding by the deadlines is the sole responsibility of the student. Any non-compliance with the respective deadlines results in the grade 5 (deadline fail).

Please note the **special regulations** related to COVID-19 **for deadlines**:

In the summer semester 2020, the following exception has been defined:

The deadlines of the winter semester 2019/2020 usually due by 14th March 2020 are automatically postponed to 14th March 2021 (without former request for approval by the students). Deadlines of the summer semester 2020 are automatically postponed to the summer semester 2021.

Examinees who need to take their re-sit exam on the grounds of deception or plagiarism in the previous semester will be granted a deadline extension until the summer semester 2021.
