Compulsory **exam registration is possible from 16.04.2021 to 30.04.2021**. In light of the particularities related to the Corona pandemic, any exam registrations made after this period of time are **not** possible.

De-registration is not compulsory, but as in the previous semester, it is urgently requested, at the latest by the 7th day before the examination.

As in the previous semester, a **medical certificate** must be submitted in case you need to withdraw from an examination due to sudden illness. This medical certificate needs to state clearly that the sudden illness could not have been known prior to the start of the examination. As usual, the examination committee decides on the recognition of the certificate. Any subsequent de-registration from an examination is **not** possible in this semester.

For **written attendance examinations (schr.P.)**, the DIT's hygiene regulations in force at the time apply. The examination rooms will be announced on the examination schedule shortly before the examination. Please arrive early for the examination due to possible hygiene measures and also plan some extra time.

For **student research projects (PStA)**, the latest submission date is stated on the examination schedule. The respective examiner defines the deadline and processing time of the student research project as well as the form of submission (e.g. via iLearn upload).

Oral examinations (mdl.P.) are usually conducted via web conference. You will receive the dialing link and schedule from the respective examiner. You must have a microphone and a camera activated for the entire duration of the examination and you must be alone in the room. During the examinations, you must be able to identify yourself with your student ID.

For **distance examinations according to BayFEV**, the following applies: The examiner is responsible for the proper conduct of the examination. For details on the examination, see the iLearn course or ask your examiner. In particular, there is the option of a written attendance examination instead of an online examination. If you choose an online exam, the examiner's specifications according to iLearn apply. There is continuous supervision of the examination via web camera (video supervision according to BayFEV). Sound and image must be activated during the entire examination. No other persons are allowed in the room. Only the specified aids may be used. The risk of technical problems is borne by the candidate; the examination may be deemed not to have been taken.

Take-home examinations (written examination at home) are a mixed form of a written examination and an examination paper. All auxiliary aids are permitted. The examination is taken as a distance examination at home. Since this form of examination does not require supervision, no alternative written attendance examination is offered. The technical implementation is carried out by means of the iLearn platform. The time indicated on the examination schedule shows the net process time. An additional 15 minutes have been granted for uploading the files (technical buffer).


Due to the dynamic Corona situation, **changes to any section of the examination schedule are possible** at short notice in order to ensure the feasibility of the examinations. Please inform yourself before your respective examinations on a daily basis.


Please note the regulations for **re-sit examinations**:

- There is no automatic exam registration for re-sit examinations. Therefore, you also need to register independently for re-sit examinations!
- Any failed first attempts at exams need to be taken again in the following semester.
- Any failed second attempts at exams need to be taken again, at the latest two semesters after the second failed attempt.

Correct adherence to the respective deadlines is the sole responsibility of the students themselves. Any failure to meet these deadlines will result in the grade 5 (deadline fail 5s). You can find the deadlines set on your Primuss grade sheet.
